Step back in time for our 90-minute guided walk-and-talk on the making of a market town. Join the tour as we trace Leominster's long history, from the foundation of its minster church and first monastery in AD 660.

Hear how the medieval town became an important centre for pilgrimage and trade despite major upheavals, including occupation by a Welsh army and near-destruction by fire.

The easy-paced tour via historic landmarks of the Leominster story begins and ends at Corn Square.


